Azerbaijan - Malign Influence Assessments:

From 2018 - 2022, we conducted ongoing assessments of obstacles and opportunities for USAID Azerbaijan funding and programming, focusing on the political, economic, and cultural setting in which the U.S. competes to assist the people and government of Azerbaijan to reform, modernize, and maintain their independence and sovereignty as well as malign influence mapping.



Tillaberi, Niger – Rapid Complexity Data Mapping:

In 2017, we collected 2,400 community perception surveys in multiple local languages in 10 days with 16 local enumerators. We delivered bespoke programming recommendations to clients and host government stakeholders.



Zambales, Philippines - IUU Community Fishing Cooperatives and Malign Influence Data:

In 2021 we organized, trained, and mobilized fishing cooperatives operating to collect data on illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing and foreign malign influence in the West Philippines Sea. We distributed our data to local government units and national maritime partners among other trusted stakeholders.
