



## **Using Data to Understand** Communities

All of our projects begin with data mapping, where we organize and train local enumerators to conduct large-scale, geotagged, and structured community perception surveys. This way, we are able to understand problems and their potential solutions through the perspective of affected populations. By conducting data analysis, disaggregation, and producing data visualizations, we are able to use this data to inform and communicate our programming and priorities.

IMPL. PROJECT utilizes a powerful data integration and analysis platform, which allows us to analyze and share the data we collect with our partners, donors, and the communities we serve. Before programming takes place, our partners are able to see a robust geospatial, graphic report of the surveyed focus communities.
